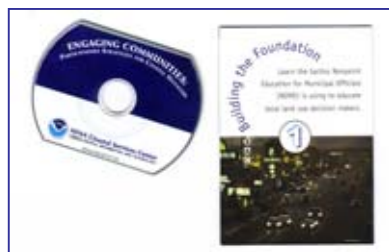
Network projects continue to mature and grow. Pictured are the NY NEMO brochure and the OH NEMO web site.
